Fixed-Price Ophthalmology

Our Ophthalmology service provides an extensive range of treatment and care for routine and urgent referrals. Using the highest level of medical and surgical techniques with the most advanced equipment, our specialist-led team is happy to provide advice or to accept your cases on a referral basis.

To support a smooth referral process and for transparency and predictability of costs for your clients, we offer a number of fixed price procedures.

Cataract surgery	
Unilateral cataract surgery	£4,000
Bilateral cataract surgery	£5,000

Procedure includes:

- An initial consultation with a member of our specialist-led Ophthalmology team
- The following preoperative investigations (if applicable):
 - Electroretinography
 - Ocular ultrasound – performed by our specialist-led Diagnostic Imaging team

- The cataract surgery itself (including placement of an artificial lens)
- General anaesthesia (including neuromuscular blockade performed by our specialist-led Anaesthesia team)
- Twice daily postoperative examinations and 24-hour intraocular pressure monitoring during hospitalisation
- 24-hour nursing care (with support provided by our 24-hour onsite vets)
- Hospitalisation for up to three nights (as required)
- First re-examination appointment

The fees do NOT include laboratory tests (including pre-operative blood testing) or medications as these can vary significantly between patients.

1 eye	£2,250
2 eyes (new procedure)	£2,750
Cherry eye surgical correction	
Unilateral	£2,000
Bilateral	£2,500
Entropion surgery	
1-2 eyelids	£2,250
3-4 eyelids	£3,500
Complex entropion procedure	£4,500
Bilateral medial canthoplasty	£2,500
Superficial keratectomy	£2,500

Each procedure includes:

- Initial consultation with a member of our specialist-led Ophthalmology team
- The surgery itself including general anaesthesia provided by our specialist led Anaesthesia team
- Up to one night of hospitalisation (if required)
- 24-hour care provided by our onsite nurses and veterinary surgeons
- First re-examination

The fees do NOT include laboratory tests (including pre-operative blood testing) or medications as these can vary significantly between patients.

A multi-disciplinary approach

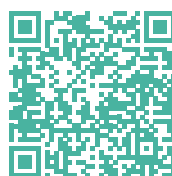
